And so it seemed an obvious choice to begin the 120th anniversary celebrations with a tribute to the sea. It is a source of life, and we have a duty not only to protect it, but to ensure that each of us, young and old alike, has the chance to discover the sea. Some will be learning about it for the first time, others renewing a fond acquaintance.

Throughout April, the municipal authority of Saint-Jean-Cap-Ferrat will be organising a variety of interactive events, on themes including:

Art: exhibitions of photography, pictures, archaeology and circular art, introducing visitors to the rich diversity of the marine world, and the dangers that threaten it.

culture: a lecture on plankton, and a screening of the film "Génération Grand Bleu" followed by a debate, will unlock the mysteries of the deep.

Science and education: visit our Marine School and marvel at the plankton workshops.

ecology: help to clean up Saint-Jean's beaches and take part in creative workshops, learning about the philosophy of sustainable development to which our town has long been committed.

CHILdren: activities and shows for youngsters.

SqiLing: free boat trips to discover the marine world, a meeting with our local fisherman Arnaud, and the chance to see the cetaceans in the Pelagos sanctuary are all on the programme.

La fête de La Mer: two days of fascinating activities and gatherings, with a film and debate, photographic and educational exhibitions, a communal sardinade, boat trips, and cinema.

the big HUMAN cHain: a unique experience to show our deep attachment to our Sea and our constant commitment to protecting it.

We hope to see lots of you here at some point during this spring month, to share in our show of affection for the sea. We owe her so much, and she deserves to be cherished!




